**Broward County, Florida** – Upon the resignation of State Representative Jared Moskowitz, the Broward County Supervisor of Elections is pleased to announce a **Special Election** for the **Office of State Representative, District 97**.

***Qualifying Details***

- Candidates seeking to qualify by the petition method must obtain **276 valid signatures**.
- Candidates qualifying by the petition method must be submitted to the supervisor of elections in the county in which signatures are collected no later than **5 p.m., February 8, 2019**.
- Qualifying fees for those candidates not qualifying by the petition method are as follows:
  - Partisan: **\$1,781.82**
  - No Party Affiliation: **\$1,187.88**
- Qualifying dates for this Special Election will be from **8:00 a.m., Wednesday February 13 through Noon, Thursday February 14**. Please note, all candidates must qualify with the Florida Department of State, Division of Elections and not at the Broward County Supervisor of Elections.

- Special Primary Election: **April 9, 2019**
- Special Election: **June 18, 2019**
