WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

- U.S. Representative in Congress, District 20 General Election - All voters in the district will be able to participate in this election.
- State Senate, District 33 Democratic Primary Election - Florida is a “closed primary” state. Only voters who are registered as a Democrat will be able to vote in this race.
- Florida House, District 94 Universal Primary Election - Since all qualified candidates for this office have the same party affiliation and the winner will have no opposition in the General Election, this is a “Universal Primary Contest” in which all voters may vote.
