Vote-by-Mail Ballots to Be Mailed for the 2022 Primary Election

Ft. Lauderdale, Florida – The Broward County Supervisor of Elections would like to remind all Broward voters that the **Primary Election** is on August 23, 2022.

On July 21, 2022, over 300,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots for the Primary Election will be mailed to domestic voters. Voters are reminded to **sign their Vote-by-Mail Ballot Voter Certificate Envelope** before mailing it back to the elections office. Voters that want to vote by mail must request a ballot no later than **August 13, 2022**.

Vote-By-Mail ballots have pre-paid postage built into the return envelopes. Voters returning a Vote-By-Mail ballot by mail should provide as much time as possible for the USPS to deliver the ballot as ballots must be received – not post-marked – by 7:00pm on Election Day, August 23rd.

There will be many secure ballot box available starting July 25th for voters to deliver their ballots to the Supervisor of Elections. Visit www.browardvotes.gov for location information.

Important Dates and Information for the Primary Election

- New voters must be registered by Monday, July 25, 2022
- Party changes must be done by Monday, July 25, 2022
- Early voting will be available from August 13 – August 21, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- **Election Day is Tuesday, August 23, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**
