CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Nina Di Pietro at 5:00 p.m.

Motion to approve minutes from last Canvassing Board meeting was granted by Canvassing Board members.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall presented Military/Overseas Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballots (stored in a bag with seal# 0725982) to the Canvassing Board members for their review. Permission requested for (10) Military/Overseas VBM ballots to be open and processed was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(9) Military/Overseas VBM ballots are good to be tabulated. (1) Military/Overseas VBM ballot needs to be duplicated. Duplicated ballot with Dup# 010170 was reviewed by Canvassing Board members. Motion that ballot was duplicated correctly was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

The Canvassing Board members compared numbers from the ES&S Results against the Official Results Certificate before signing. Supervisor Scott explained that 219 voters voted for a write-in candidate. This number of votes is reflected on the ES&S Systems Results; however, the actual count of votes for the qualified write-in candidate is 19 which is on the Official Result Certificate. Canvassing Board members signed Official Results Certificate.

Canvassing Board members reviewed and signed the Conduct of Elections Report.

Motion to grant permission to the election staff to begin the Post-Election Audit was approved by the Canvassing Board members.

State Senate, District 33 race was selected for the audit. The precincts selected for the audit are: C029, C037, G008 and M007. Canvassing Board members reviewed the numbers tallied for each precinct (VBM, EV, ED) versus the ES&S report. Numbers matched 100%. Canvassing Board members signed the Voting System Post-Election Audit Report.
