CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Daniel J. Kanner at 4:30 p.m.

Motion to approve minutes from preceding Canvassing Board meeting was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

BOARD TO CONSIDER, AS NEEDED

(1) Duplicated VBM ballot with duplicate # 010324 presented for review. Motion that VBM ballot is duplicated properly and permission to tabulate ballot was granted by the Canvassing Board member.

(2) Undervote VBM ballots presented for review. Motion that ballots are undervotes was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Mary Hall explained to the Canvassing Board members that due to a power failure with the printing machine, some fax transmittals didn't go through until machine started working. The fax log shows the time that each fax was sent to the Elections office. Motion to review what was received via fax was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Vote-by-Mail ballots stored in an orange bag with seal #s 1948460 and 1948491.

(2) VBM ballots with Cure Affidavits presented for review. Motion to approve, process and tabulate VBM ballots was granted by Canvassing Board members.

(26) VBM ballots signed by other than voter with a VBM request on file. Ballots were closely reviewed by Canvassing Board members and (25) ballots were approved. Motion to reject (1) ballot with different address was granted by the Canvassing Board members. Motion to process and tabulate approved ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(35) VBM ballots with different signatures. Canvassing Board members voted on each ballot. (19) VBM ballots were approved and (16) VBM ballots were rejected. Motion to process and tabulate accepted VBM ballots.

Fax Transmittal reviewed and (5) UOCAVA ballots received and presented for review. Motion that ballots were properly reproduced and to be sent for tabulation was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Signed VBM ballots by other than voter and no request on file for signee. Motion to reject ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(5) VBM ballots from voters who sent Cure Affidavit but did not provide Tier 1 or 2. Motion to reject ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(3) VBM ballots returned by deceased voters. Motion to reject ballots was granted by Canvassing Board members.

(1) VBM ballot signed by other than voter and voter was deceased. Motion to reject ballot was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(1) MARG voter submitted VBM ballot. This is a first-time voter voting by mail and didn't provide picture ID as required by law. Motion to reject ballot was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(6) Voters submitted VBM ballots and moved out of county. Motion to reject VBM ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(10) Voters submitted VBM ballots and moved out of precinct. Motion to reject VBM ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(1) VBM ballot received from voter that voted at the polls on election day. Motion to reject VBM ballot was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(56) VBM ballots with no signatures and no Cure Affidavits received. Motion to reject VBM ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Provisional ballots stored in red bag with seal #0726745.

(3) Provisional ballots from election day. (2) provisional ballots are recommended to be accepted since voter was at correct precinct and signature matches. Motion to approve ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members. (1) provisional ballot from a voter that voted by mail and showed up to vote on election day. Motion to reject ballot was granted by the Canvassing Board members. Motion to tabulate (2) approved ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
