2. Approval of Minutes from the Preceding Meeting
3. Board to consider/review as needed:
  - a. Determine validity of challenges/protests
  - b. Review ballots for determination of voter intent questions
  - c. Review the following categories of duplicated ballot materials for accuracy and instruct SOE staff to tabulate validly duplicated ballots as applicable:
    - i. Duplicated Damaged Ballots
    - ii. Duplicated Voter Intent Ballots
    - iii. Duplicated Overseas & Military Ballots
  - d. Review separated Blank Ballots, Undervotes, and Overvotes for accuracy.
  - e. Review voter cure affidavits and supporting documentation and determine whether to accept or reject as appropriate.
  - f. Review provisional ballots and determine whether to accept or reject as appropriate.
  - g. Review and reject ballots with no signed voter certificate.

If you decide to appeal any decision made by the Canvassing Board, you will need a record of the proceedings, and you may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made. See § 286.0105, Florida Statutes.

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- h. Review and determine treatment of envelopes with multiple ballots.
  - i. Review and reject envelopes with no ballot.
  - j. Review ballots of deceased voters and documentation to determine whether to accept or reject as appropriate.
  - k. Other ballot items for Board consideration
  - l. Provisional ballot review
4. Beginning at 5:15 p.m.:
- a. Certification of Election Results and approval of the Conduct of Election Report.
  - b. Conduct of the Post-Election Audit (immediately after Certification of Election Results).
    - i. Selection of the Race and Precinct(s) for the Post-Election Manual Audit.
    - ii. After the audit is completed, make results available to the public and approve Manual Audit Report.
