

## ALL BROWARD COUNTY FORM-1 FILERS

### **Instructions for submitting Form 1 Statement of Financial Interest**

The Florida Commission on Ethics requires persons holding certain governmental positions to file a Financial Disclosure by July 1, annually. If the annual form is not filed or postmarked by September 1, an automatic fine of \$25 is imposed for each day late up to a maximum penalty of \$1,500.
