SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION (#229)

November 2, 2021

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

- On May 26, 2021, Governor Ron DeSantis called a Special Election for filling the vacancy of the office of U.S. Representative in Congress, District 20, and has also called a Special Primary Election for selecting nominees of the recognized political parties for such election.
- Florida is a “closed primary” State meaning that only voters within a political party may vote in that party’s Primary Election.
